## Camper Code of Conduct

Our hope is that Camp Akita will be a place for campers to build authentic relationships with God, self, others, and nature. In order for Camp Akita to be safe, fun, and enjoyable for everyone, there are some expectations to discuss with your child. Camp Akita has the right to remove a camper from any virtual camp session without warning if the Camp Director suspects any of these codes of conduct have been violated.

1. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking or tobacco products are not allowed during the hours of virtual camp.
2. Sexual, discriminatory, suggestive, or other inappropriate behaviors/comments/conversations are unacceptable. Bullying or other significant aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.
3. Campers will only use the Zoom platform to contact camp staff and fellow campers during the scheduled camp times.
4. Screen shots, recording, and private, separate chats are not allowed during virtual camp sessions.
5. My background will be appropriate, such as, but not limited to, a blank wall, virtual background image, or the images provided by Camp Akita.
6. I will follow the guidelines for appropriate chat conversations.
  - a. If you ever feel uncomfortable, tell your trusted adult.
  - b. No secrets. (Surprises are different. Surprises make us feel good and are intended to share eventually. Secrets are not ever meant to share and can feel bad.)
  - c. Good messages are ones that parents/guardians are excited to see and hear and the person sharing it with you would want your parents/guardians to see and hear the message.
  - d. Cussing, swearing, and foul language are not acceptable.
